

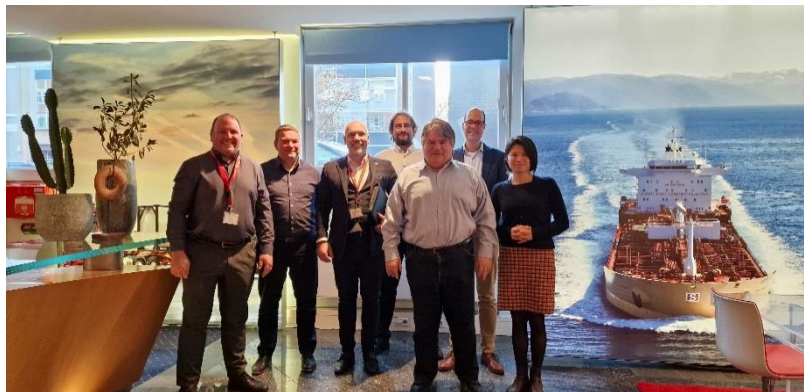
Stolt Tankers signs SMART Maintenance contract with NSSLGlobal
